Application information:

- The class/group students must be between the ages of 14 and 19 years old.
- Please submit a video/CD presentation to the SYTA Youth Foundation and share why your class is in need of this travel experience as well as how you feel it would benefit your students.
- The video must be less than 15 minutes long.
- The sponsorship is for a group **no larger than fifty people**, and the destination will be determined after the recipients are announced.

All applications must be submitted not later than **May 31, 2008**.
